Bar Exam Format

The Delaware Bar Exam is a 2.5-day exam. Delaware has not adopted the Uniform Bar Exam (UBE).

Day 1: Eight Delaware essay questions.

Day 2 (half day): Two 90-minute Multistate Performance Test (MPT) questions.

Day 3: Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), a six-hour, 200-question multiple-choice exam.

Subjects Tested

Delaware Essay Subjects: Agency, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Corporations, Criminal Law (including the Delaware Criminal Code), Equity, Evidence, Partnerships, Procedure (State and Federal), Property, Torts, Trusts, Uniform Commercial Code, Wills

MPT: "Closed universe" practical problem using instructions, factual data, cases, statutes and other reference material supplied by examiners.

MBE: Federal Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts.
