Bar Exam Format

The Georgia bar exam is a two-day exam. Georgia has not adopted the Uniform Bar Exam (UBE).

Day 1: Two 90-minute Multistate Performance Test (MPT) questions in the morning and four 45-minute essay questions in the afternoon.

Day 2: Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), a 200-question, multiple choice exam.

Subjects Tested

Multistate Performance Test: "Closed universe" practical questions using instructions, factual data, cases, statutes and other reference material supplied by examiners.

Georgia Essay Subjects: Business Organizations, Georgia Practice and Procedure, Constitutional Law, Non-Monetary Remedies, Contracts, Professional Ethics, Criminal Law and Procedure, Property, Evidence, Torts, Family Law, Trusts, Wills and Estates, Federal Practice and Procedure Uniform Commercial Code (Articles 2, 3 & 9)

MBE Subjects: Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts.
