Bar Exam Format

The Maryland bar exam is a two-day exam. Maryland has not adopted the Uniform Bar Exam (UBE).

Day 1: Ten Maryland state essays written by the State Board of Law Examiners and the Multistate Performance Test (MPT) published by the National Conference of Bar Examiners (NCBE).

Day 2: Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), a 200-question, multiple choice exam.

Subjects Tested

Maryland State Essays: Agency, Partnerships, Associations, Business Associations, Commercial Law, Family Law, Maryland Civil Procedure, Professional Responsibility.

MPT: "Closed universe" practical question using instructions, factual data, cases, statutes and

MBE: Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts.
