Bar Exam Format

The North Carolina Bar Exam is a 2-day exam. North Carolina has not adopted the Uniform Bar Exam (UBE).

Day 1: 12 Essay Questions written by the North Carolina examiners.

Day 2: Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), a 200 question, multiple-choice exam.

North Carolina Essay Subjects

Business Association (including agency, corporations, and partnerships), Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Family Law, Legal Ethics, Real Property, Secured Transactions (including The Uniform Commercial Code), Taxation, Torts, Trusts, Wills, Decedents' Estates, Equity

MBE: Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts.
