Bar Exam Format

The Virginia bar exam is a two-day exam. Virginia has not adopted the Uniform Bar Exam (UBE).

Day 1: Nine essay questions and multiple-choice exam written by the Virginia bar examiners.

Day 2: Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), a 200-question, multiple-choice exam.

Subjects Tested

Virginia Essay Subjects: Agency, Criminal Law, Professional Responsibility, Uniform Commercial Code, Conflict of Laws, Domestic Relations, Real and Personal Property, Virginia Civil and Criminal Constitutional Law, Equity Sales, Procedure (including Contracts Evidence Taxation appellate practice), Business Organizations, Federal Practice and Procedure, Torts, Wills and Estate, Administration Creditor's Rights, Local Government Law, Trusts.

MBE: Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts.
