### Student Instruction

The Learning and Study Strategies Inventory (LASSI) is designed to help you think about learning and study practices and attitudes. Different statements will be presented that relate to your knowledge of these areas.

If you are ready to begin:

1. Go to: <http://www.collegelassi.com/>
2. Read the directions for taking the LASSI.
3. Enter the UW Law School number listed below along with your user name and password.

4. After entering the information, the next screen to appear requires you to enter your first and last name in the spaces provided for the page to be submitted correctly. The ID and E-mail fields are optional.
5. The next screen to appear will be the LASSI assessment.

You will be asked to respond to 60 short statements. To help you decide which responses to select, please note what is meant by each option for the purposes of this assessment.

- By **Not at all typical of me**, we do not necessarily mean that the statement would never describe you, but it would be true of you in rare instances.
- By **Not very typical of me**, we mean that the statement generally would not be true of you.
- By **Somewhat typical of me**, we mean that the statement would be true of you about half of the time.
- By **Fairly typical of me**, we mean that the statement would generally be true of you.
- By **Very much typical of me**, we do not necessarily mean that the statement would always describe you, but that it would be true of you almost all the time.

Once you are done answering the questions:

- A two-page report will be displayed listing your scores for each scale and an explanation of your results.
- You may print a copy of the results for your records.
- The AEP will send you an email message with further instructions.
