Bar Exam Format

The Michigan Bar Exam is a 2-day exam. Michigan has not adopted the Uniform Bar Exam (UBE).

Day 1: 15 Essay questions written by the Michigan examiners.

Day 2: Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), a six-hour, 200-question multiple-choice exam.

Subjects Tested

Michigan Essay Subjects: Real and Personal Property, Wills and Trusts, Contracts, Constitutional Law, Criminal Law and Procedure, Corporations, Partnerships, and Agency, Evidence, Creditor's Rights, including mortgages, garnishments, and attachments, Practice and Procedure, trial and appellate, state and federal, Equity, Torts (including no-fault), The sales, negotiable instruments, and secured transactions articles of the Uniform Commercial Code, Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct, Domestic Relations, Conflicts of Laws, Worker's Compensation

MBE: Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts.
