Bar Exam Format

The Georgia bar exam is a two-day exam. Georgia has not adopted the Uniform Bar Exam (UBE).

Day 1: Two 90-minute Multistate Performance Test (MPT) questions in the morning and, four 45-minute essay questions on Georgia law in the afternoon.

Day 2: Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), a six-hour, 200-question multiple-choice exam.

Subjects Tested

Multistate Performance Test: "Closed universe" practical questions using instructions, factual data, cases, statutes and other reference material supplied by examiners.

Georgia Essay Subjects (<https://law.mercer.edu/academics/registrar/course-descriptions/bar-exam-topics.cfm>): All 7 MBE Subjects, Business Organizations, Family Law, Georgia Practice and Procedure, Non-Monetary Remedies, Professional Ethics, Trusts, Wills and Estates, Uniform Commercial Code (Articles 2, 3 & 9)

MBE Subjects: Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts.
