## **Bar Exam Format**

The Georgia bar exam is a two-day exam. Georgia has not adopted the Uniform Bar Exam (UBE).

**Day 1:** Two 90-minute Multistate Performance Test (MPT) questions in the morning and, four 45-minute essay questions on Georgie law in the afternoon.

Day 2: Multistate Bar Exam (MBE), a six-hour, 200-question multiple-choice exam.

## **Subjects Tested**

**Multistate Performance Test:** "Closed universe" practical questions using instructions, factual data, cases, statutes and other reference material supplied by examiners.

**MBE Subjects:** Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts.
