This two-year fellowship supports graduate students engaged in research on socio-legal studies at UW-Madison.

### **About the Program**

ILS Law & Society Graduate Fellows are doctoral (PhD and SJD) and advanced research students drawn from a range of disciplines across the UW-Madison campus, including (but not limited to) those in the Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities, International Studies, Schools of Public Health, Business, Education and Public Policy, and Law.

The Program strives, in an interdisciplinary setting, to (1) enrich students' understanding of important research topics and design/methodological issues and to expand their research skill set; (2) further develop students' ability to critically evaluate their own research and that of their peers and other researchers; and (3) assist students in preparing for the dissemination of their research. These goals are achieved through meetings with graduate student peers and faculty Directors Professors Heinz Klug (fall) and Mitra Sharafi (spring), attendance and participation in program sessions, and sharing of students' own work in a seminar setting.

Fellows are expected to attend **all** monthly workshops. In addition, they are expected to provide each other with written comments for each paper that is workshopped. The workshops will take place from 2:00pm-4:00pm on the following Fridays at the Law School:
