Know your limitations, and the limitations of law in general.</li> <li>●Know what preconceptions do you have about people who aren't lawyers?</li> <li>●Have a sense of humility about your professional contributions</li> </ul>		
<i>Parley-Too</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>●Know what words, acronyms and usages are unique to your profession.</li> <li>● Listen for similarities and differences. What are the other professionals like?</li> <li>●Be understood – don't just talk at your team members, make sure you are communicating.</li> <li>●What do the other professionals know already? What do the other professionals need to know in order for the team to be effective? What do the lawyers need to know?</li> </ul>
